Archery Committee

The Archery club gets together Monday night indoors from 7 till 9 to shoot a round of 3D targets.

The indoor range has a green arrow curtain that can be pulled in front of the pistol backstop. The curtain is rated for a 50lb bow using blunt bullet tip points. We have target bails and foam blocks to be placed between the targets and the curtain. This is to prevent damage to the curtain and to your arrows in the unlikely chance you miss.

On the outdoor archery range target houses have been placed at 20, 30, 40 and 50 yards. Crossbow speed bags are installed on all the target houses. Please put the crossbow speed bags back on top of the foam blocks to keep them out of the weather when you are finished.

Good News! Broadheads can be shot at the Styrofoam blocks in the target houses. Just be careful when removing the broad heads and pulling out large chunks of the foam.

PLEASE DO NOT SHOOT BROADHEADS AT THE "CROSSBOW SPEED BAGS" OR ANY OTHER TARGET ON THE CLUB GROUNDS.

Pistol Team/Indoor Range

One of the questions newer shooters often have is "How far back should I stand?"

Definitely you must be back at least seven yards, which puts you behind the red line on the floor

Standing closer puts you in danger of being hit by bullet fragments that sometimes bounce out of the trap. Opting to stand all the way at the back of the room is a problem because new shooters often cannot hit the bullet trap from that distance. Instead, they inadvertently fire rounds into the floor, the walls, or the ceiling. Shooting into the ceiling causes a secondary problem in that the bullet can easily continue through the roof, resulting in one or more leaks. To avoid damaging the roof, you must be certain that your shot will hit the trap.

Start at the red seven-yard line and fire a few rounds at your target. Next, count the holes in your target. If all your shots hit the target, then you can consider backing up a bit. From eight or nine yards try the same exercise. If any of your shots miss the target completely then you are at your limit.

You should practice at this distance or closer until all your shots are "on paper". Wondering if you can hit the target from the back of the room will tempt you to go beyond your ability. Trying things that are beyond your ability is always a bad idea when it involves a gun! **Please:**

- Only shoot paper targets.
- Approved calibers posted on the range.
- Place finger on the trigger ONLY when ready to fire. -SAFETY FIRST.
- Unsafe practices damaging BVFG range or property may cost your membership.
- Please take out the trash when the containers are full. Clean up all your brass.
